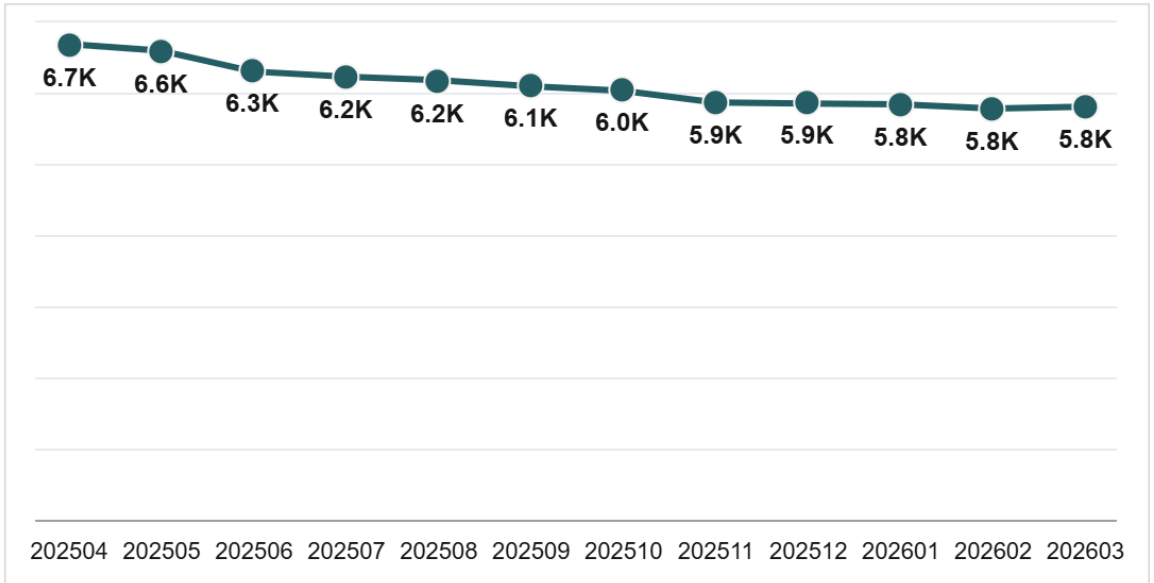

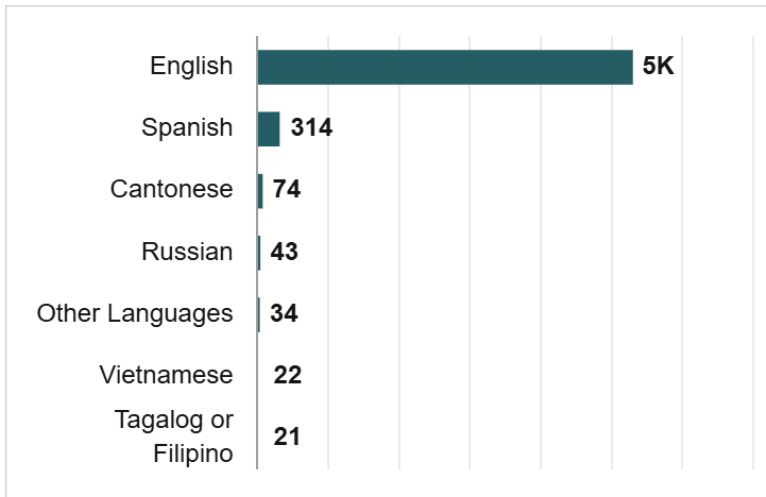

## CAAP Persons Over Time

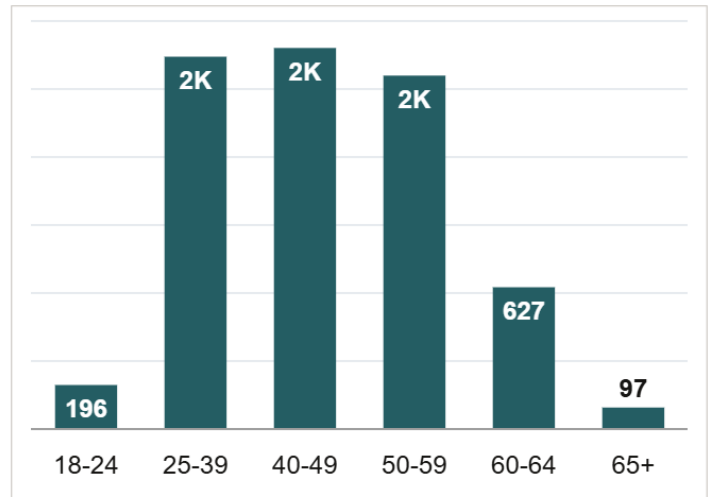

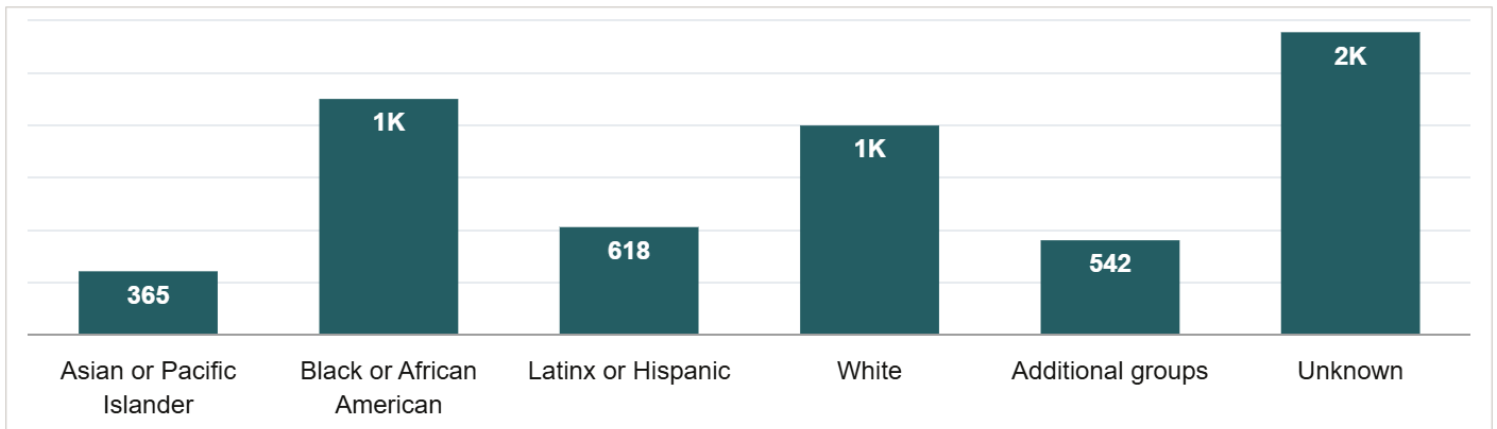
## CAAP Persons by Primary Language



## CAAP Persons by Age Group

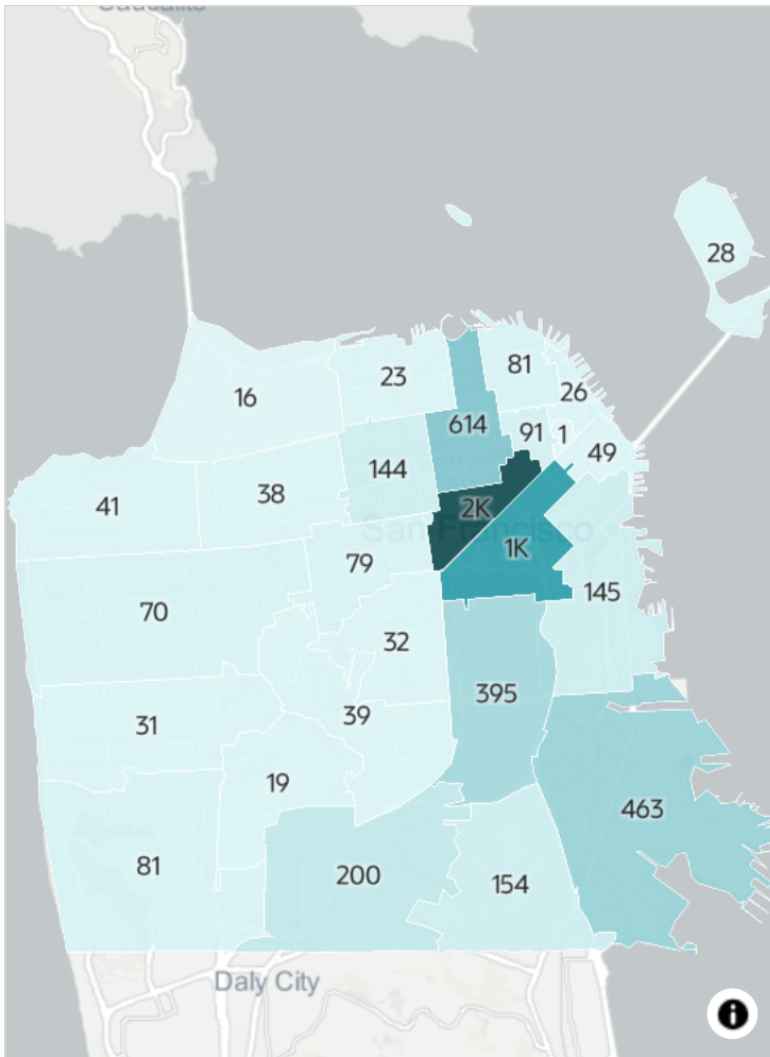


## CAAP Persons by Race/Ethnicity
