Current Project/Mission: *Identify and advocate for social engagement opportunities for those who are socially isolated due to long-term care needs and/or placement.*

Agenda:

Discussion re: next steps of a potential USIRS Pilot

- **Stakeholder meeting with USIRS:** Discussed purpose of the next meeting/conversation with USIRS and key stakeholders
- **Potential Stakeholders:** Aurora (Mission Neighborhood Center); Joanne Holland (SF Health System and a GetCare representative); someone from the Friendship line; Kimochi or another API org; another City Dept (Fire Dept, EMT, etc.); affordable housing property managers (RAD sites?); UCSF researchers; Rick Appleby; OpenHouse; Self Help for the Elderly; Bayview Senior Center; RACS; 30th St.; HSA planning unit; HSA IT; Social Engagement members; DAS Intake; discharge planner
- **Other considerations:** Russian translation? And this body should present findings/next steps to the OAC next summer, 2021
- **Additional Questions:**
 - How involved would USIRS be in the long-term? (if need to adapt or increase languages)
 - Don't know enough to know what the gaps are – a SF specific presentation and then a follow-up meeting for questions/concerns
 - How to keep group at a manageable size
 - Setting the expectation – frame it as current tool (we're doing due diligence about what's out there, no decisions are being made, see something that is off the shelf) – does it help to share that until this, tool for social isolation OR loneliness
 - Record presentation? Get permission and only share in a certain situation
 - Can we view the translated tool?
 - Providing enough time to get feedback from people, time wise schedule near the next SE meeting
 - What does the community need? How are they finding/not finding socially isolated community members? As a way to bring people in to having a conversation, relationship building.
 - Goal: identify people at risk and to be able to connect them to services
 - Consider having meetings in phases? (Phase 1: technical/data/base competency (is it working and who is it working for) then a Phase 2: pilot and more in-depth cultural competency and community engagement)
