Current Project/Mission: *Identify and advocate for social engagement opportunities for those who are socially isolated due to long-term care needs and/or placement.*

 - Optimistic, this is a good start
 - have spent time validating scales and researching, very encouraging
 - still no research around actual interventions
 - very accessible tool
 - questions about the actual referral process
 - **Survey results:** walked through results
- **Next Steps:**
 - **Small pilot or scrap it? Where to go from here:** Discussed what the scope of the pilot might look like (ie DAS Intake or case managers) and what it wouldn't include (citywide roll-out, discharge planners or relationships not developed)
 - Assessment would need to be more accessible to people with development disabilities and/or cognitive impairment (ie change to simple/clear language)
 - Roll out the pilot without the cultural competency or pause until can do that
 - Consider including the SF health plan in the pilot?
 - Consider incorporating program evaluation as part of the pilot – such as phases, milestones, etc.
 - More discussion about potential partners, roll-out, thinking of the connection to services (need for warm handoff), if there are comparable communities also rolling this out, consider having a national network of partners using USIRs
 - Decision is that we move forward with pilot – very exciting! Though there's a lot of next steps (meet with specific folks, ensure cultural competency, etc.)
