

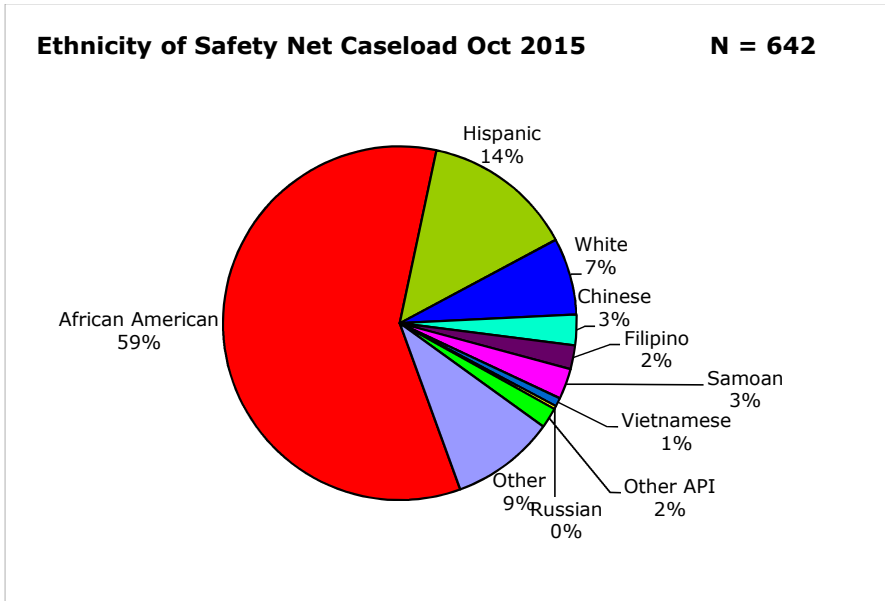
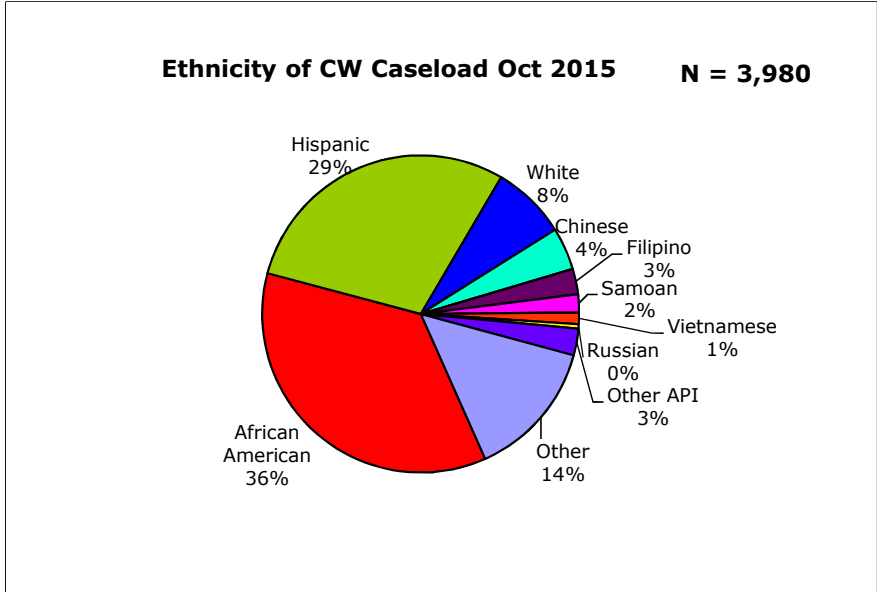

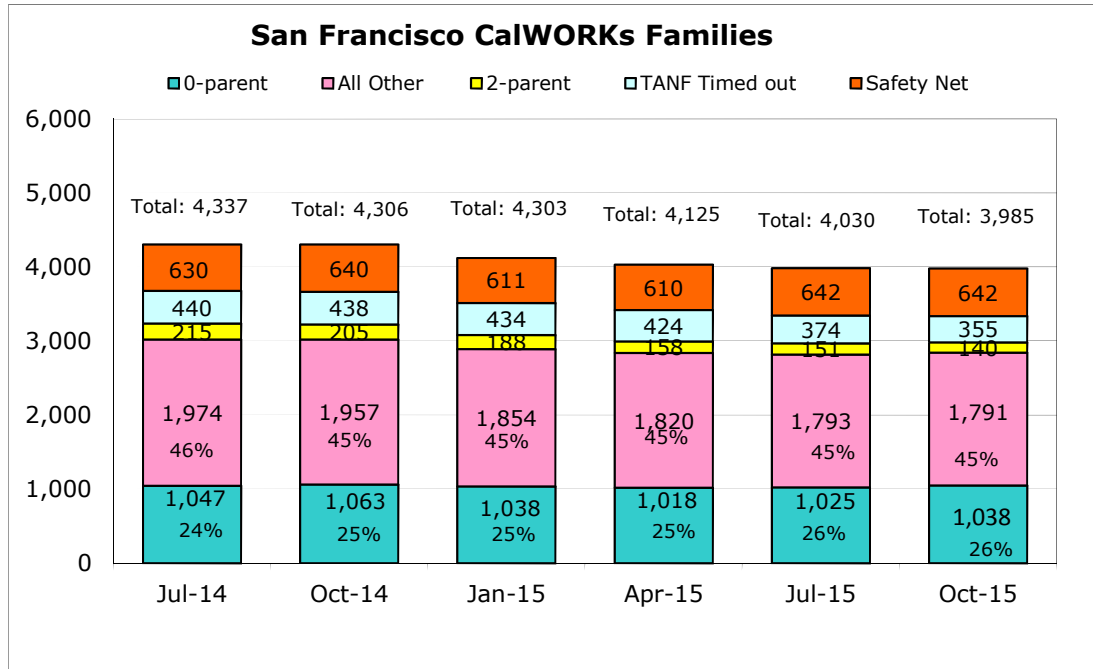
Since November 2014, CalWIN database separately identifies CalWORKs families that receive assistance under Trafficking and Crime Victims Assistance Program. There were 18 TCVAP families in November 2014. As of October 2015, they had risen to 85 nearly a five fold increase.
