






Highlights:


- 1 The number of MC enrollees increased by 76,102 between Oct 13 and Apr 2015, a rise of 75%.
- 2 MAGI persons account for 44% in April 2015 compared to 39% in Jan 2015, a rise of five percentage points.
- 3 As expected, the number of MAGI recipients is highest in the age group of 25-64 years.








Highlights contd.:

- 4 Seniors account for 22% of the total MC recipients, declining by three percentage points from Jan 2015.
- 5 Between October 2013 and April 2015, MC Households (HHs) rose by 72% (a rise of 47,994 HHs).
- 6 There has been a consistent and gradual rise in the number of CalFresh and CAAP HHs that also avail of Medi-Cal services.

Highlights contd.:

- 7 More than half of all MC HHs speak English, followed by Cantonese at 23%.
- **8** Excelsior, Mission, Bayview and Visitacion Valley account for 38% of the total HHs.
- 9 Chinese are the largest ethnic group among MC HHs (29% of the total) followed by the Hispanic and White at 18% each.
- Other includes a high number of HHs with unknown or unreported ethnicity (12,596) accounting for 11% of all HHs.

Other Highlights

- Long Term Care (LTC) recipients are small in number, i.e. 1,419 (less than 1% of all recipients).
- Share of Cost (SOC) MC persons account for 7% of the total MC enrollees (12,127) declining slightly by one percentage point over Jan 2015.
