






### Highlights:


- 1 One year after ACA was rolled out, the number of MC enrollees went up by more than half (52%), a rise of 53,025 persons.
- 2 MAGI Individuals account for 39% of all MC recipients.
- **3** As expected, the number of MAGI recipients is highest in the age group of 25-64 years.







- 4 A fourth of all MC enrollees are seniors (37,042).
- **5** Between October 2013 and January 2015, MC caseload rose by 67%, a rise of 44,252 households (HHs).
- 6 The number of CalFresh and CAAP cases on MC has risen steadily in the same period.

### Highlights contd.:

- 7 More than 50% of all MC HHs speak English followed by Cantonese at 23%. Spanish accounts for 12%.
- 8 Excelsior, Mission, Bayview and Visitacion Valley account for 38% of the total HHs.
- 9 Chinese are the largest ethnic group among MC HHs (30% of the total).
- Other includes a high number of HHs with unknown or unreported ethnicity (11,989) accounting for 11% of all HHs.
- Long Term Care (LTC) recipients are small in number, i.e. 1,357 (less than 1% of all recipients).
- Share of Cost (SOC) MC individuals account for 8% of the total recipients (11,832).
