

VETERANS CAN GET PRIORITY IN THE CITY'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING LOTTERIES!

Veterans rank highest within certain housing lottery preference categories through the San Francisco Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development.

How to Apply

1. Check if you qualify

You or someone on your housing application must have served in the active US military, naval, or air service (discharge was under conditions other than dishonorable), AND qualify for at least one of the housing lottery preferences:

- Certificate of Preference (COP)
- Displaced Tenant Housing Preference (DTHP)
- Neighborhood Resident Housing Preference (NRHP)
- Live or Work in SF Preference

2. Apply to the housing lottery on DAHLIA

Apply to a lottery to buy or rent affordable housing. Answer the questions regarding your US military service, as well as any other preference you may qualify for.

3. Share preference documentation when we contact you

Before the lottery, we will ask you to send us a document to verify your military service. You only need to do this once for our records. If you qualify, your application will get priority within a preference category. If you do not qualify, you will be included in the General Lottery category.
