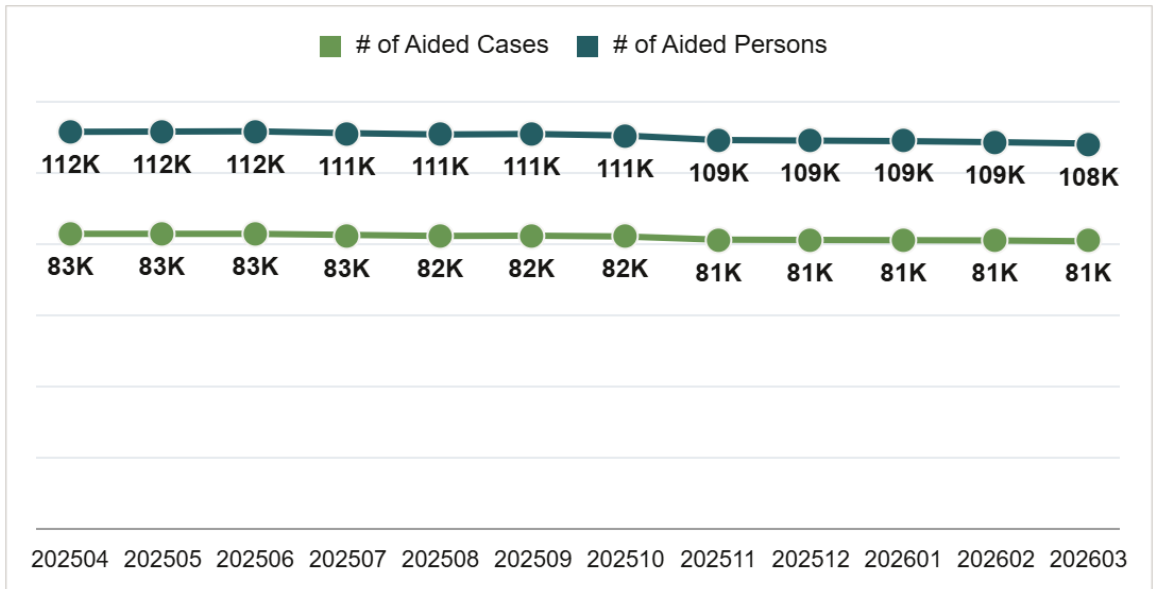

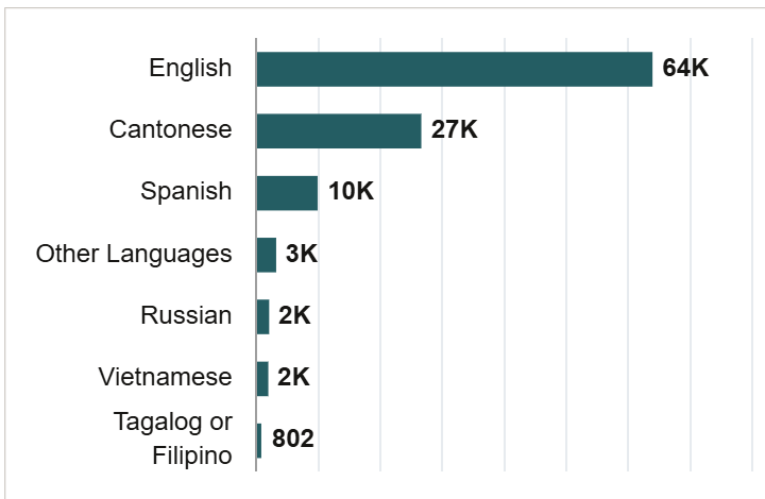

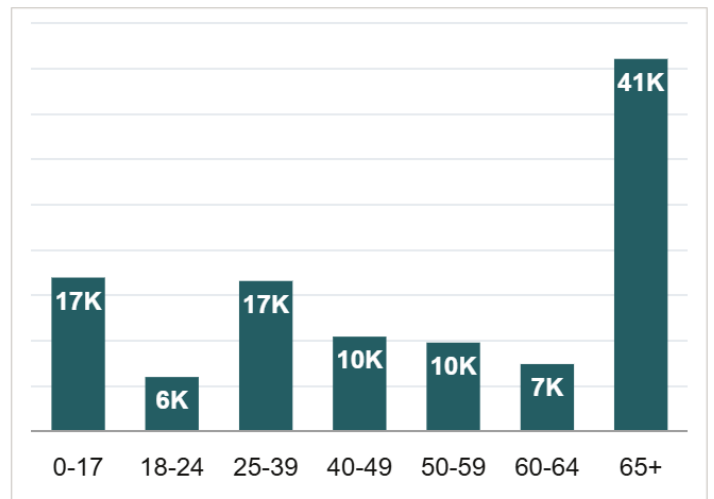

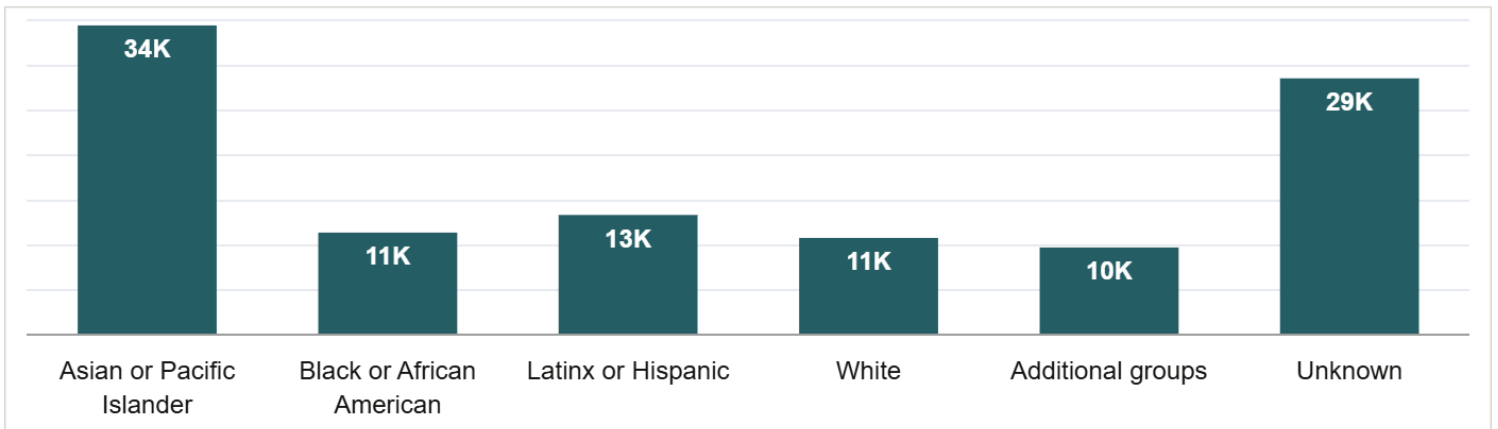
CalFresh Persons by Primary Language



CalFresh Persons by Age Group

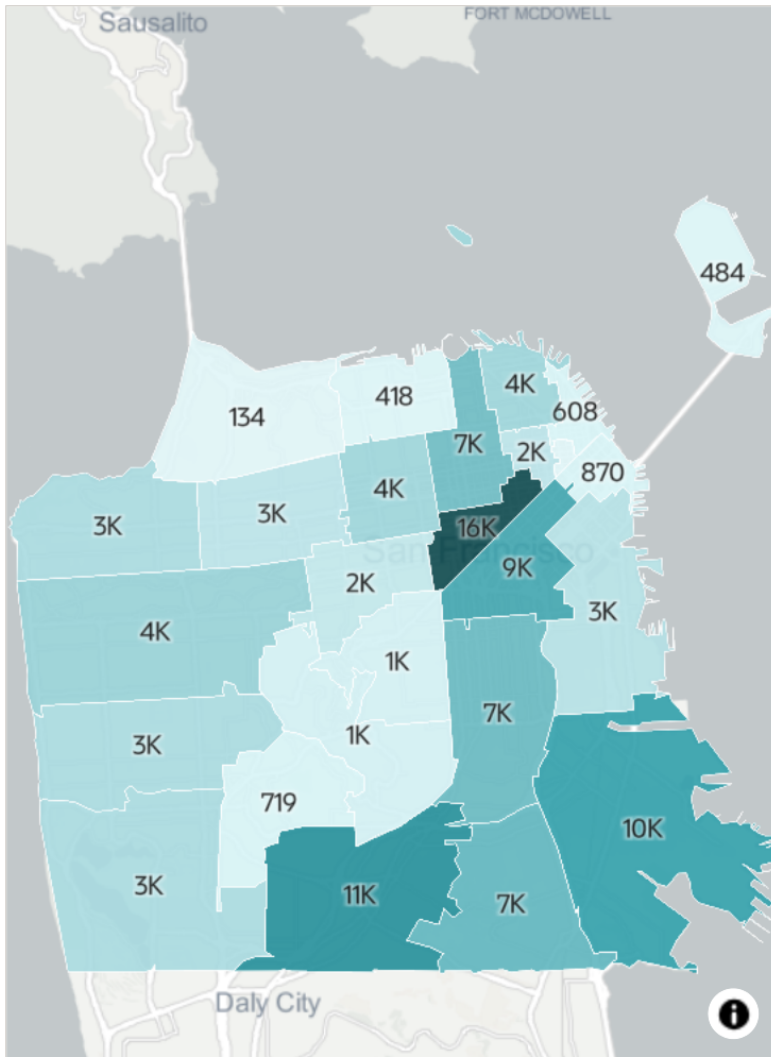


CalFresh Persons by Race/Ethnicity
