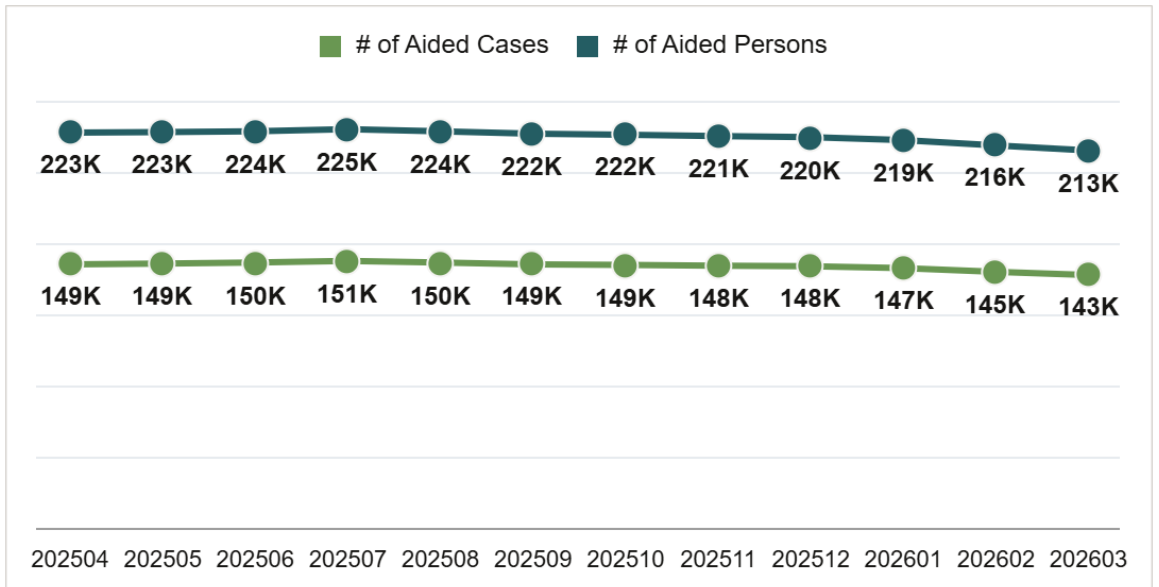

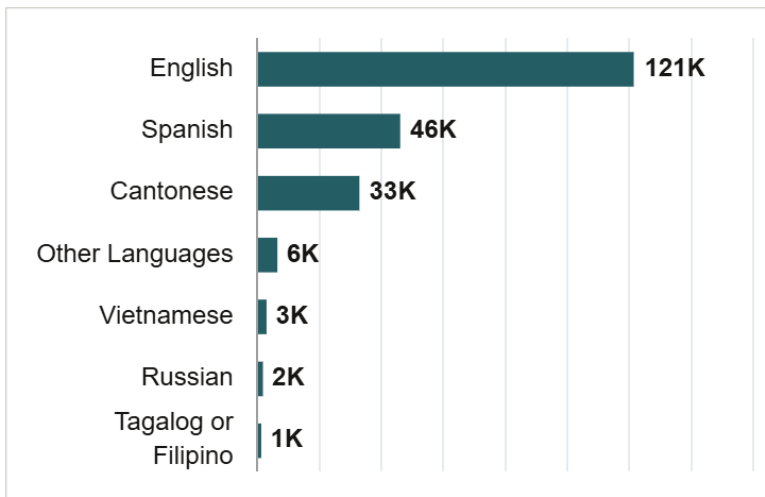

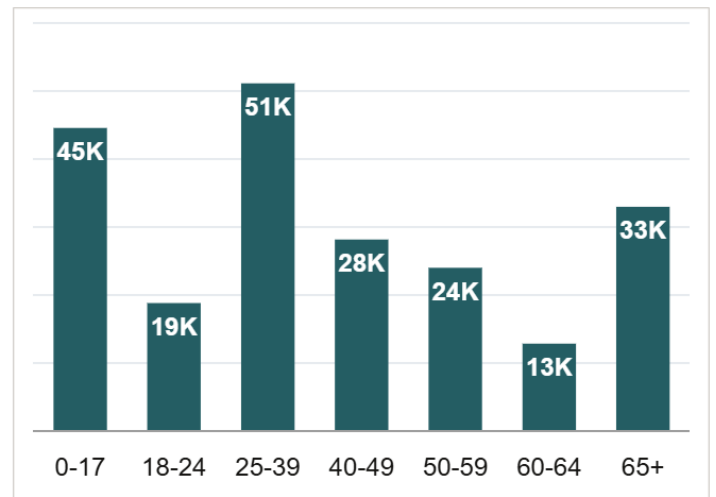

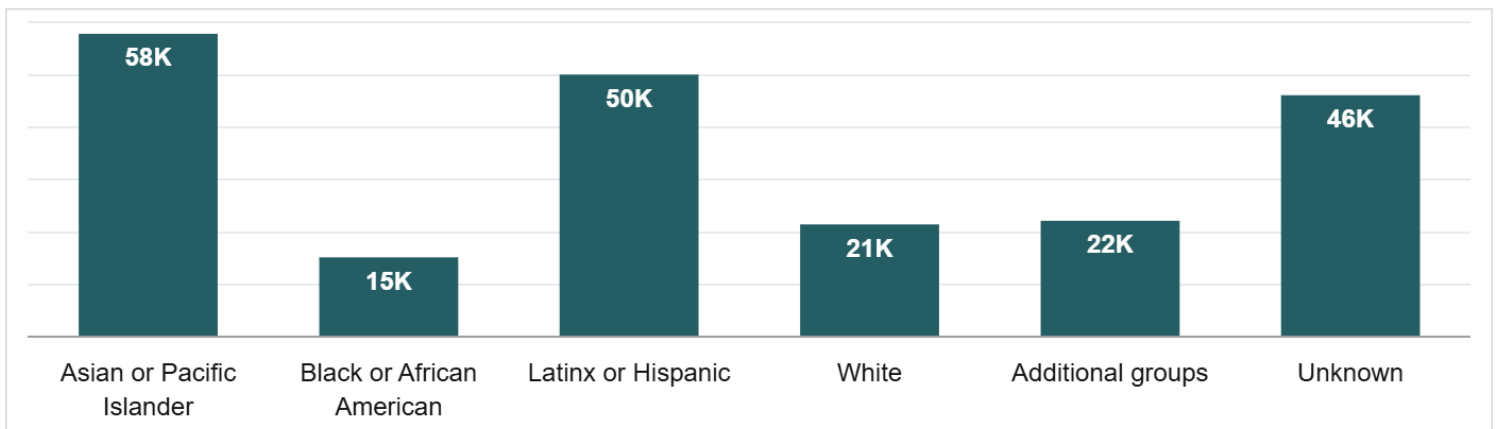
Medi-Cal Persons by Primary Language



Medi-Cal Persons by Age Group

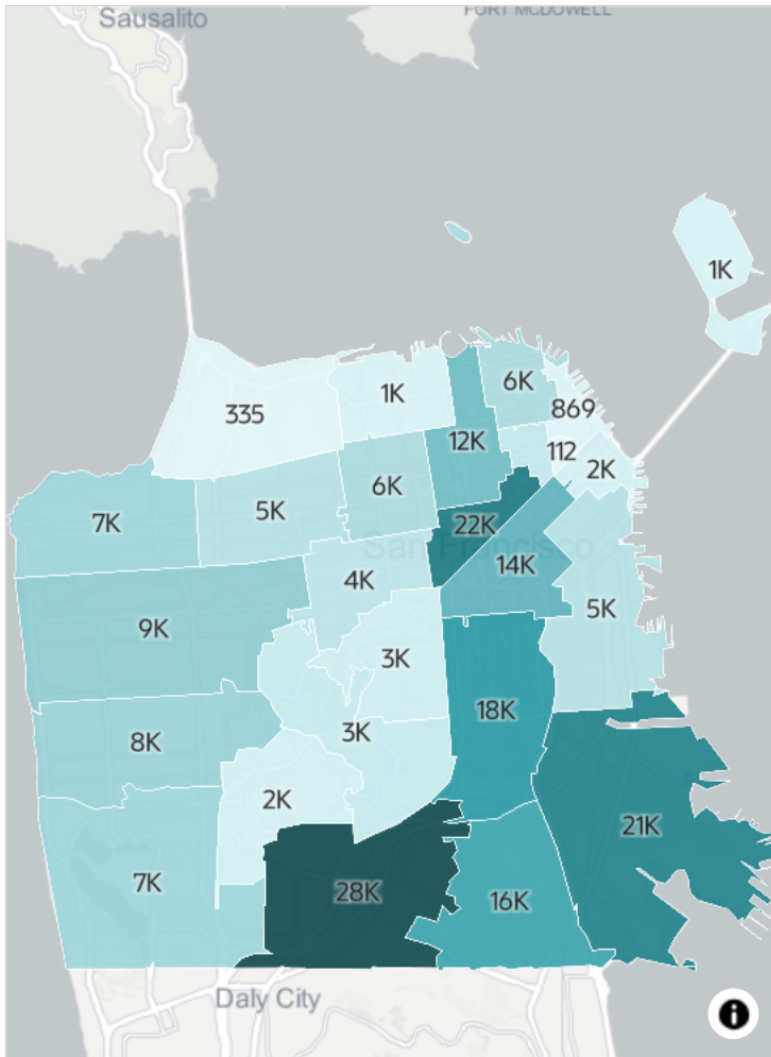


Medi-Cal Persons by Race/Ethnicity
