SUBJECT: **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MIPPA CONTRACT MI-1718-06 AND ASSOCIATED BUDGET, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS**

INTRODUCTION

The Department is seeking review and approval of the FY 17/18 MIPPA (Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers) budget and associated contract MI-1718-06.

Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers Act (MIPPA) Background

This funding provided through the MIPPA grant is specifically intended to increase Medicare beneficiary enrollment in the Prescription Drug Benefit Low-Income Subsidy program, the Medicare Savings program, and Medicare Part D. The grant also promotes an expansion in outreach activities related to preventing disease and promoting wellness. The MIPPA Grant was awarded to the State for a three year period (which began in FY15/16) – however, the funding is allocated in one year increments. DAAS has been informed of the \$53,529 allocation for San Francisco for January 1, 2018 through September 29, 2018.

The Department is proposing to allocate this funding as follows:

Self-Help for the Elderly (ADRC MIPPA)	\$11,009
TOTAL	\$53,529

Attached for your review and approval are two documents:

- The first document is the contract MI-1718-06 that is presented for your review and approval. This is the standard agreement between DAAS and the State which reflects all of requirements related to the program and funding sources.
- The second document is the Department's *MIPPA Budget* for January 1, 2018 through September 29, 2018, which allocates the funding in both the program and administration.

Recommended Action: Approve the FY 17/18 MIPPA Budget, MIPPA Contract MI-1718-06 and all subsequent amendments.
