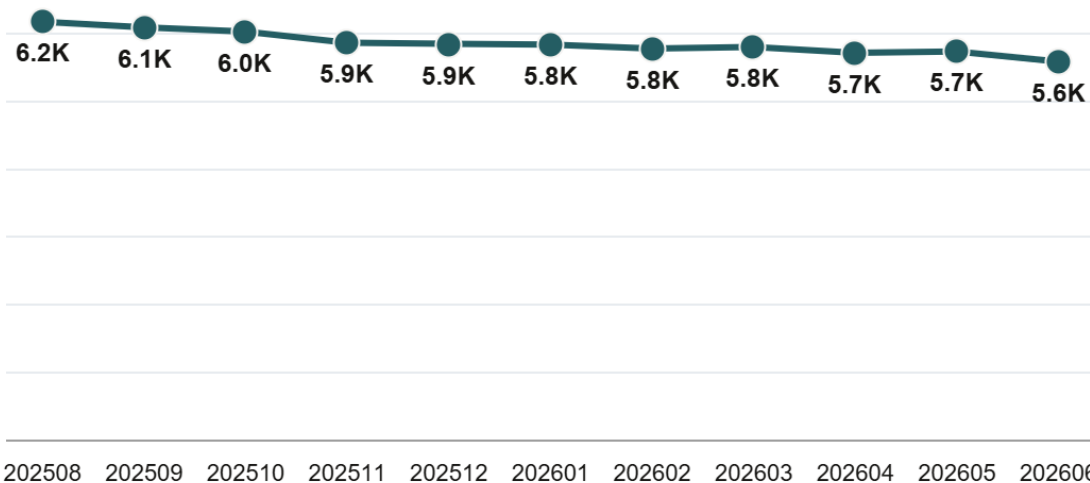

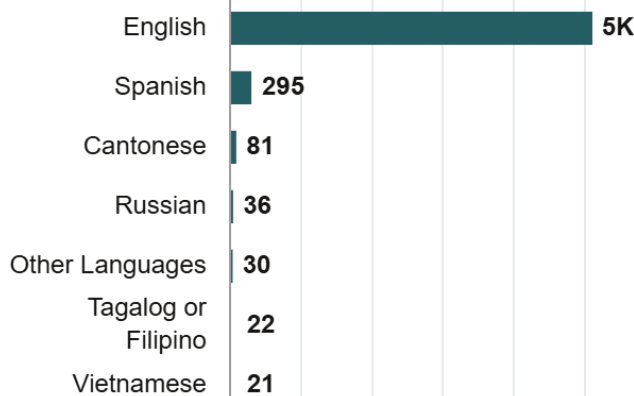

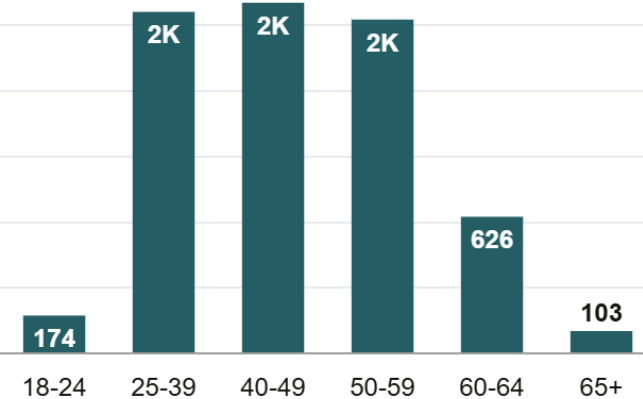

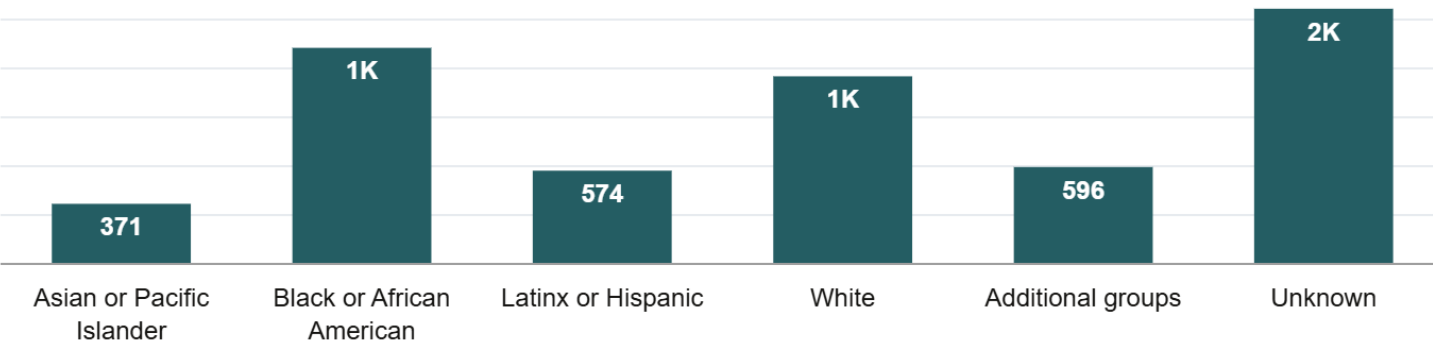
CAAP Persons by Primary Language



CAAP Persons by Age Group

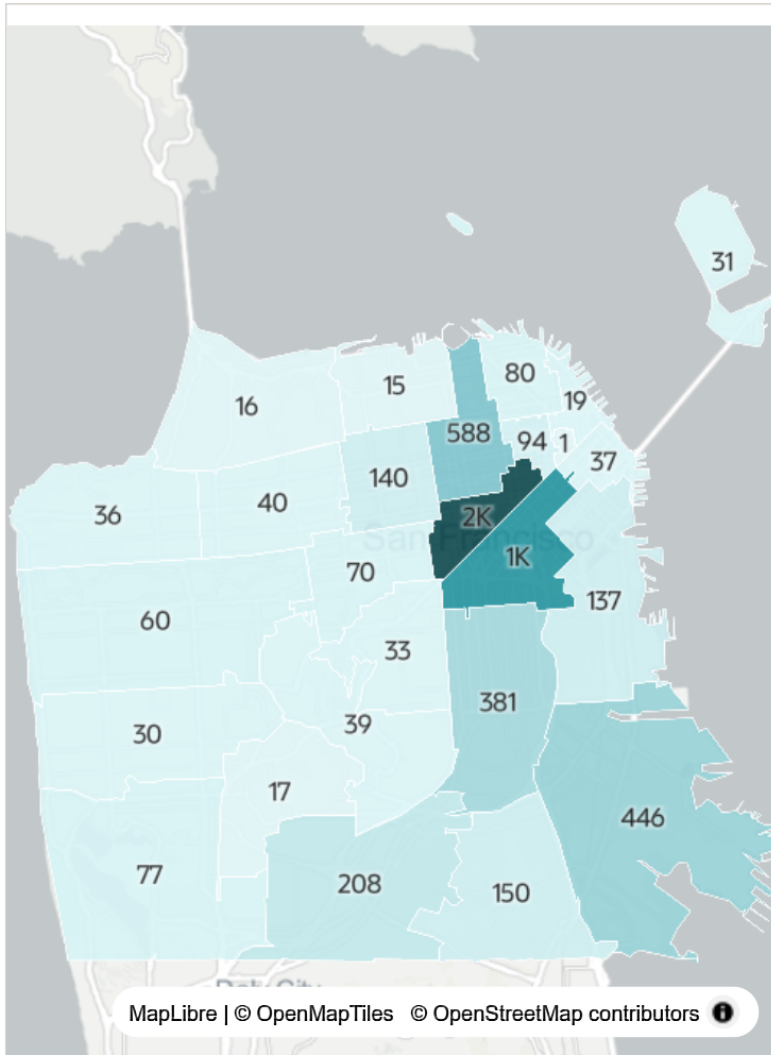


CAAP Persons by Race/Ethnicity
