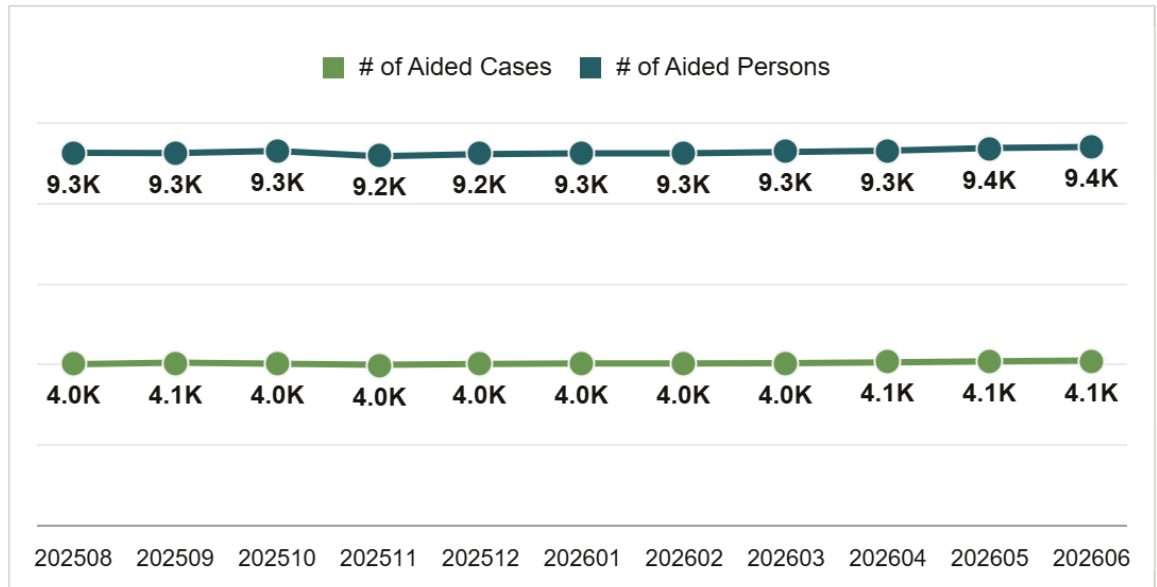

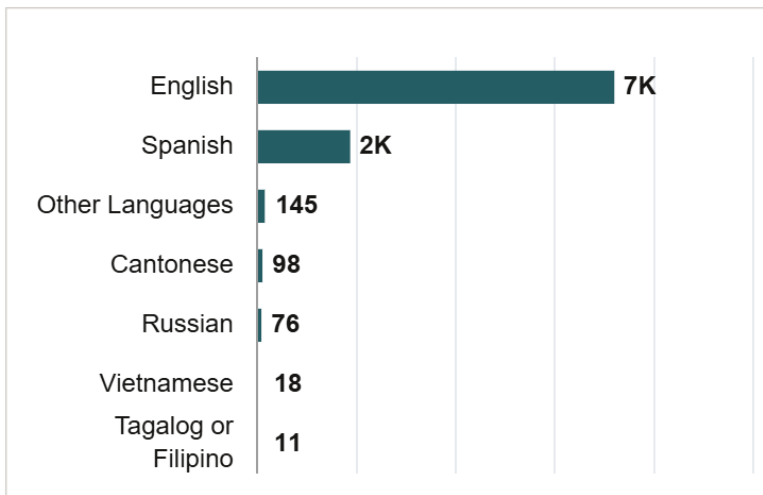

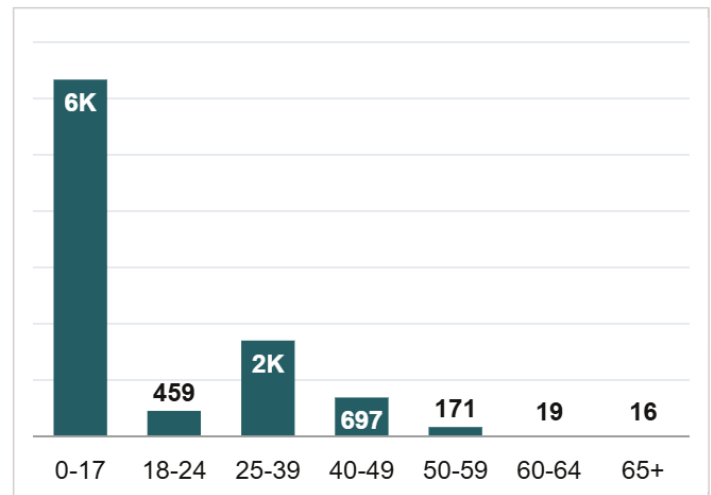

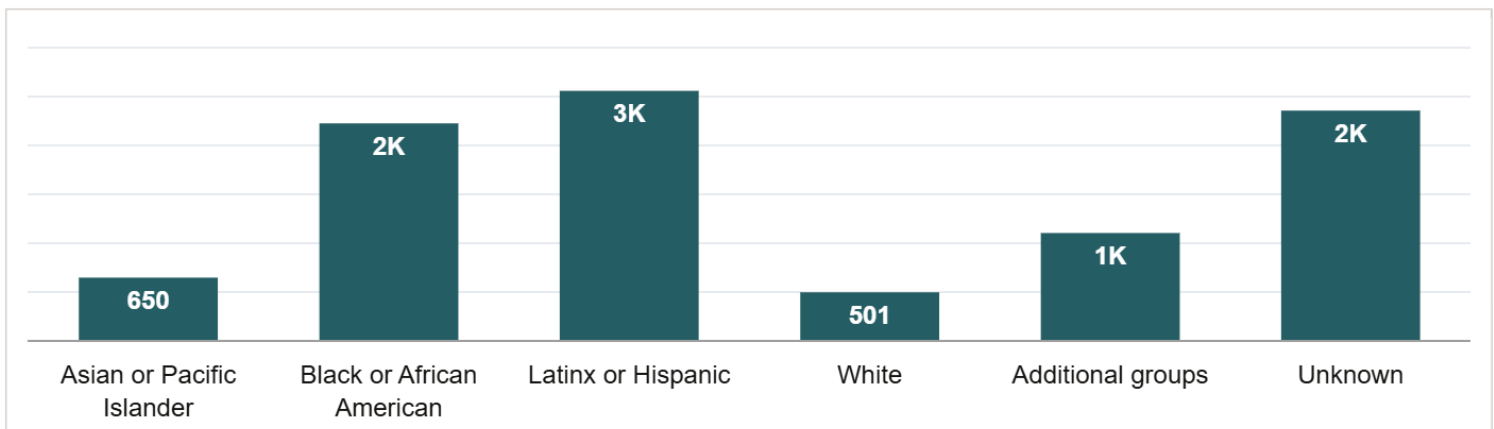
CalWORKs Persons by Primary Language



CalWORKs Persons by Age Group

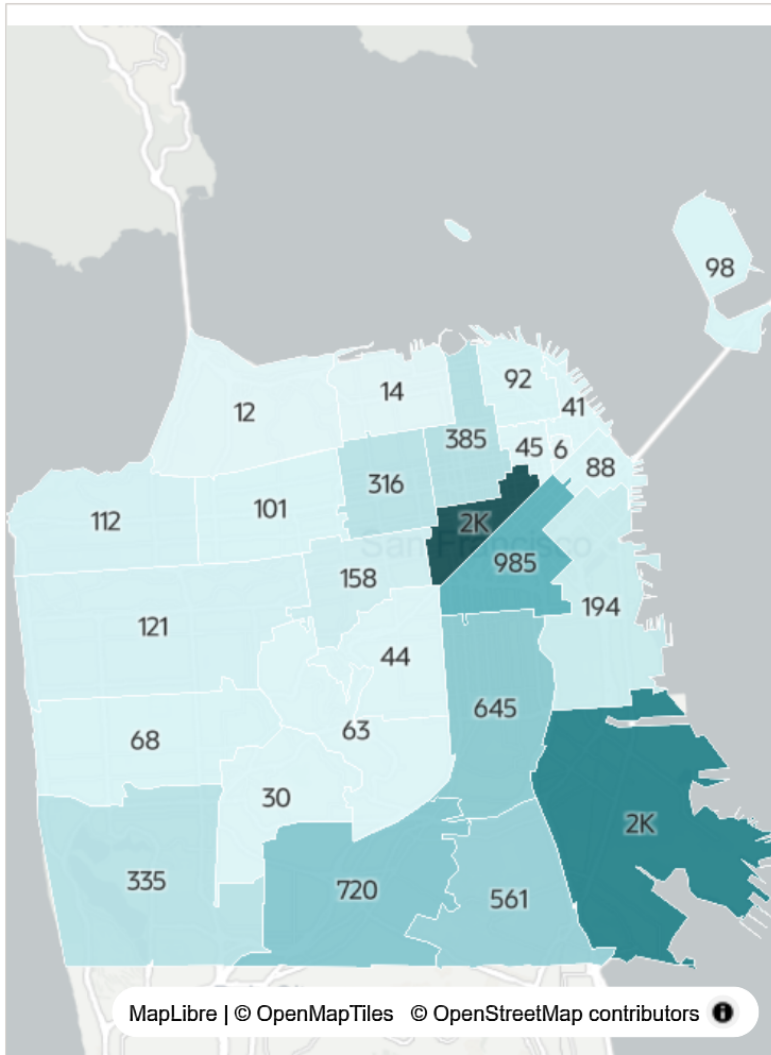


CalWORKs Persons by Race/Ethnicity
